

### **Accounting 101 - Financial Accounting**

Skills Expected: Reading 5; Writing 5; Listening/speaking 5; Math 3

Coursework:

30 to 75 pages of reading per week

2 to 5 math-related homework assignments per week

6 exams per semester (involving multiple-choice, true-false, short-answer, and essay questions; math skills are required)

### **Accounting 105 - Introductory Accounting I**

Skills Expected: Reading 5; Writing 5; Listening/speaking 5; Math 3

Coursework:

10 to 30 pages of reading per week

2-3 math-related homework assignments per week

5 exams per semester (involving multiple-choice, true-false, short-answer, and essay questions; math skills are required)

### **Accounting 110 - Basic Accounting I**

Skills Expected: Reading 5; Writing 4; Listening/speaking 4; Math 3

Coursework:

10 to 32 pages of reading per week

2 to 8 pages of math-related homework per week

5 exams per semester (with multiple-choice, true-false, short-answer, and essay questions; math skills are required)

### **Accounting 130 - Payroll Accounting**

Skills Expected: Reading 5; Writing 5; Listening/speaking 5; Math 3

Coursework:

10 to 21 pages of reading per week

2 to 4 pages of math-related homework per week

5 exams per semester (involving multiple-choice, true-false, short-answer, and essay questions; math skills are required)

### **Accounting 150 - Principles of Income Taxation**

Skills Expected: Reading 5; Writing 5; Listening/speaking 5; Math 3

Coursework:

1 term/research paper (3-4 pages) per semester

1 to 5 math-related homework assignments per week

3 exams per semester (involving multiple-choice, short-answer, and essay questions; math skills and some analysis of Tax Code are required)
