CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

The Curriculum and Instruction committee of Glendale Community College shall have the responsibility for developing the educational program in accordance with the philosophy and objectives of the College for recommendation to the administration and the Board of Trustees. With the leadership to be offered by the Curriculum and Instruction Committee, all certificated personnel of the College, both administrative and teaching, are responsible for continuing revision of curriculum. Community groups and advisory committees may submit requests for new courses or curricula and recommend revisions for existing curricula. All proposals relating to curriculum development should be submitted to the office of the Vice President, Instructional Services, who will be responsible for the processing of the proposals to the Curriculum and Instruction Committee, and finally to the Board of Trustees, who shall have final authority.
