The purpose for the third meeting with your EOPS counselor is to assess your success in reaching the objectives set for this term, the success of the programs and services provided in meeting your educational goal, and to assist you with preparation for the next term of classes, or to make future plans if you are leaving EOPS Program or the college. You are encouraged to use as many GCC student services as you may need or referred to by your EOPS counselor, however, no visits with counselors outside of EOPS will count towards meeting the EOPS counseling meeting requirement.
