Dear EOPS Student,

EOPS Mutual Responsibility Contract requires students to meet with EOPS counselor in order to maintain their continued eligibility with the program. EOPS students are required to meet with their EOPS counselor 3 times during each semester (fall/spring), and 1 time during each intersession (winter/summer if registered). This counseling requirement must be met regardless of student's registration status (i.e. registered in less than 12 units), and student's academic standing (i.e. probation/dismissal). Counselors may request additional visits, if needed.

Here is how your EOPS Counseling Meeting Requirement may be met:

- Meet with your EOPS counselor on APPOINTMENT or WALK-IN basis. During your second visit, remember to discuss your winter and spring class schedule.
- Attend one of the EOPS GROUP COUNSELING sessions designed for new students who have not completed SD 100 course (open link next for complete schedule) http://glendale.edu/index.aspx?

1 meeting/week: You may visit your EOPS counselor as many times a week as needed, however, only one meeting per week will be counted towards the counselor meeting requirement.

You are encouraged to use as many GCC student services as you may need or referred to by your EOPS counselor, however, no visits with counselors outside of EOPS will count towards meeting the EOPS counseling meeting requirement. If you are also with DSPS and/or Scholars programs please review specific information pertaining to counseling meeting requirements for students in these programs (click on link to review Counselor Meeting Requirements and deadlines)
