Committee Reports:

- A. Negotiations
 - The MOU for working 10 hour days this Winter Session from Jan. 6 – Feb. 7, 2014 should be signed today. A ballot will be coming out soon to vote on this because it needs to be approved before the next Board Meeting on Nov. 4.
 - Organizational Rights – The administration is asking that each employee get written permission to serve on any governance committee. CSEA wants to be allowed to send a memo to all managers about this practice. This is release time and should not be considered part of the lunch time.

- Wages and benefits – We are asking for a more detailed budget report for the year before we decide what to ask for in the area.
- Layoff Article – We want to write a section about reduction of year and clarify the bumping rights section.
- PGU – We want to make sure it is clear that the GCC President has the final say about disputes over PGU time if it is contested.

B. Budget Committee Update

- The budget committee voted to move \$50,000.00 from capital outlay to use for new computers for the labs on campus. The old computers will be cascaded to other areas for faculty or staff use.
- There are 3 proposals for the Milky Way Café. It was stated that the space should be leased to an already existing food establishment and not a “Mom and Pop” operation.
- The expanded budget committee will take the recommendations of the HAC committees and prioritize hiring for the positions that have gone through the process for this year.

C. Governance Committees Reports

- There are currently 4 vacancies on Governance committees. Please respond to Tzoler’s email from this morning if you are interested in filling any of these openings. Everyone who volunteers will be considered at the next CSEA executive board meeting and a member will be appointed for each.
